| Binoculars/Scopes                                      | Not allowed  |

| Cameras (including video)                              | Not allowed  |

| Privately-owned Two-Way Radios                         | Not allowed  |
| Explosives   | Not allowed  |
| *Weapons & Ammunition                                  | Not allowed *Federal, state and local law enforcement agents will secure their weapons prior to entering the NNSS.   |
| Chemical Irritants                                     | Less than 2 ounces allowed   |
| Computer Peripherals (PDAs, thumb drives, IPADS, etc.) | Must <b>NOT</b> be connected to government network   |
| Computers  | Privately-owned computers must <b>NOT</b> be connected to government resources. Laptop computers will be left in the dorm room during class. CTOS is not responsible for damaged or stolen items.        |
| Smart phones/Camera Cell Phones                        | Camera/video function must <b>NOT</b> be used at any time (subject to search and confiscation)   |
| Alcohol  | Allowed but limited to the Mercury cafeteria or in your dorm room. Open container law applies. The Nye County Deputy Sheriffs can and will issue citations if caught with alcohol anywhere else on site. |
